SBS Herbarium was first established in 1971, located in the G08 Building. It is designed to be a reference collection for the biodiversity of flora in the Northern part of Peninsular Malaysia. SBS Herbarium is aiming to support and assist the research, teaching and learning about biodiversity.

- To become the centre for the collection of Northern Peninsular Malaysia flora.
- To become a reference centre specifically for plant systematics research.
- To provide excellent facilities for local and international researchers.
- To educate and increase awareness among Malaysians on the value of their natural heritage.

BOTANICAL COLLECTIONS

The SBS Herbarium is listed in Index Herbarium and also internationally known as (USMP).

It accommodates more than 6000 specimens of plants and fungi as follows:

- >500 specimens of bryophytes (mosses).
- >5500 specimens of vascular plants (ferns, angiosperms such as orchids, palms, aroids, dipterocarps and gymnosperm).
